The Problem	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • clearly described the problem 	
The Planet	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • included a picture and an accurate description of the planet • included statement about any extremes in conditions that can affect life forms 	
Space Alien	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • gave a detailed drawing of the space alien life form • corresponds to information provided in the adaptation section of the report 	
Accommodations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • explained adaptations relating to the five human senses • explained how these senses are adaptations to the environment 	
References	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • made appropriate use of reference to give credit due to others • included four or more references 	

Style Areas	The written report:	Points
Clarity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • was easy and interesting reading • showed evidence of regular review and revision • provided examples as appropriate 	
Accuracy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • had no major errors of fact • had very few minor errors of fact 	
Completeness	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • consisted of statements that are important to the topic • explained key ideas fully 	
Depth	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • fully addressed main factors that make the topic important • showed evidence of using several major critical resources 	
Punctuation, Grammar & Spelling	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • contained an insignificant number of punctuation errors • contained few grammatical errors • contained no spelling errors 	
Format & Appearance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • was produced using a word processor or computer • used appropriate font, font size, line spacing, and border areas • had a good general appearance
